Description

The Power Platform Embark Offer provides a structured method for evaluating an organization's maturity in adopting the Power Platform. This assessment focuses on three key areas of the low-code platform: the strategic alignment and business value of the Power Platform, its administration, governance, and support mechanisms, and the efforts made to nurture and drive adoption across the organization.

Objectives

After completing this delivery, participants will be able to:

- Understand the organization's low-code migration journey and existing blockers
- Discuss and challenge the organization's strategic intent for the use of Power Platform
- Surface the current organizational Power Platform maturity level in alignment with the Power Platform Maturity Model
- Know which steps are required to improve the organization's overall Power Platform maturity across all success pillars and progress low-code adoption

Outcomes

The primary aim of this delivery is to foster healthy discussions with leadership, platform administrators, development teams, the change management team, and makers. It highlights common priorities and goals for the Power Platform adoption journey within the organization.

An additional aim of this delivery is to review how the organization is structured, how teams within the organization work, what organizational concerns may exist, and how efforts and energy can best be focused to help advance organizational maturity with Power Platform.

Assessment

Perform an in-depth evaluation with a Microsoft engineer and generate your first set of results.

Review and analysis

Analyze your results and examine the issues identified and how to remediate them.

Develop a plan

Develop a plan to help you remediate issues and improve your environment.

- Present the results and recommendations from the maturity assessment in a close-out presentation.
